**Re: 2011 APGA General Safety Meetings**

The Arkansas Propane Gas Association, along with the Arkansas LP Gas Board, will conduct fifteen (15) General Safety Meetings during April, May and June, one (1) at the 2011 Summer Convention for Convention registrants in July and one (1) make up meeting on Wednesday, October 12, 2011. A schedule of meetings is included.

Arkansas LP Gas laws require anyone transporting LP Gas (Propane) or installing propane systems to attend one (1) general safety meeting annually (generally all licensed employees). These meetings will be "Dutch Treat" dinner meetings beginning each evening at 5:30 to 6:00 pm with the safety presentation usually beginning at approximately 6:30 to 6:45 pm. The make up meeting in October will be at noon.

Kevin Pfalser with Gas Equipment Company in Little Rock will present the safety topic this year on a subject suggested by the Arkansas LP Gas Board which will be designed to give timely and proper knowledge for your use. A handout will be provided to assist each attendee.

As usual, a brief written test will be given on the subject covered to be placed in the employees personnel file to verify training. Keep in mind that each employee handling propane must attend one general safety meeting each year and these meetings and the topics are scheduled to accommodate the most persons. We strongly urge you to attend.

The registration fee for each person will be \$20.00 for APGA members and \$25.00 for non-APGA members. The cost of the meal is not included in this registration amount.

Please pre-register by completing the enclosed enrollment form and return to the Association office as soon as possible. Those registering will be expected to attend.

You may attend any meeting regardless of your company location.
